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Biographical Note

Enno Masurel (born 6 December 1959) is a Full Professor in Sustainable Entrepreneurship at the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. His educational background is business economics; in the last decade he has moved more into the direction of business administration and entrepreneurship.

His main activities are:

- 1) Education: currently the specialization course New Venture Creation and Development in the joint MSc Entrepreneurship, five electives in entrepreneurship at beta faculties and the International Summer School New Venture Creation and Development.
- 2) Supervision of PhDs: on the subjects of small business development and entrepreneurship, from the Netherlands and other countries.
- 3) Research: with focus on the determinants of successful entrepreneurship and small businesses, with special reference to innovation, sustainable entrepreneurship and the life cycle of the firm.
- 4) Impact (Valorisation): bridging the gap between the academic world on the one hand and the private sector and the public sector on the other, by showing mutual benefits and building long term relationships.
- 5) Management: he is the co-program director of the joint MSc Entrepreneurship and the director-founder of the Center for Entrepreneurship at the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam (CfE@VU).
- 6) Capacity building in Africa: supervision of PhDs and training of university lecturers in Tanzania, Kenya, Ethiopia and Zambia.
- 7) Various consultancy and advisory assignments.
