

Terms and conditions Amsterdam International Summer School ONLINE 2021

Application & Course fee

- Amsterdam International Summer School ONLINE (short: AISS ONLINE) is an online 5-day program for dancers with an advanced or (pre)professional level between 12-21 years old;
- The age of the dancers is calculated on reference date 6th of July, start of the AISS ONLINE;
- Closing date of applying to the AISS ONLINE is 31st of May;
- Within the application form you will be asked to upload 3 photo's: Demi plié in first position (en face), tendu à la seconde (en face), first arabesque (en profil);
- Participant confirms, by filling out the application form, that he/she will take part in the AISS ONLINE
- Participant confirms, by replying on the confirmation of registration that he/she is obliged to pay the course fee of € 425,00;
- Participant of the AISS ONLINE agrees with the term of payment: payment within 7 days after date of invoice;
- The invoice will be send, by the Central Student Administration of the academy, to the email address that participant has written in the application form;

Withdrawal or cancellation

- The Dutch National Ballet Academy reserves the right to retain all of the course fees in the event of the applicant's withdrawal;
- The Dutch National Ballet Academy reserves the right to cancel the AISS ONLINE in the event of few applicants or any other unavoidable circumstance;
- In the situation that the organization will have to cancel the AISS ONLINE due to too few applicants or any other unavoidable circumstances the paid course fee will be refunded to the participants;

AISS ONLINE

- The AISS ONLINE will take place online on 6th through 10th of July
- The program for 12-14 years old will take place in the timeframe of 10:00-18:00 o'clock (exact time frame to be decided)/ Amsterdam time zone (UTC +2).
- The program for 15-21 years old will take place in the timeframe of 14:00-21:30 o'clock (exact time frame to be decided)/ Amsterdam time zone (UTC +2). If there are a lot of registrations, a second time frame will be determined.
- The definite time schedule and practical information of the AISS ONLINE will be shared a week before the AISS ONLINE will start;
- Participants will receive a link to take online classes in the AISS ONLINE, this link is personal, and it is forbidden to share it online or with others;
- Participants are responsible for their own internet connection and devices;
- The organization request participants to use a device with a webcam function so the teachers and staff can be in contact with participants in order to provide feedback during the AISS ONLINE;
- During the classes, participants will follow the instructions of the teachers and staff of the AISS ONLINE;
- When participants disobey the instructions of the teachers and staff and/or guideline of the online medium and program, the organization reserved the right to disconnect the participant from the online course and can forbid the participant to prohibit further participation;
- The organization reserves the right to change the teachers or guest artists in the event of illness or any other unavoidable circumstance;
- It is the candidate owns responsibility to decide if he/she can attend the course if carrying an injury;
- By participating in the AISS ONLINE, participant consent to photography and video recordings and their publication on our website and social media;
