Onsite Location

The entrance to the Academy of Theatre and Dance is on the ground floor and can be accessed through two automatic doors. There are wheelchair-accessible elevators and several sets of stairs. The symposium takes place in the Danstheater, studio 202, de Punt. Each space has adaptable seating. Wayfinding signage is provided onsite to help guide you through the building.

The Danstheater is on the 1st floor. You can reach it by taking the staircase or the elevator from the ground floor. Staff will also be at the building's entrance to assist with wayfinding.

On each floor, you will find toilets in several locations. On the ground floor, they are located in the central hall. All toilets are gender-neutral. The door indicates whether there is a urinal or a toilet.

In the building, there are two toilets that have brackets on both sides, a sink at height for wheelchair users and an alarm cord. One of these toilets is located on the ground floor in the central hall, and the second is on the 8th floor.
